Only original horse drawn vehicle allowed to be displayed.
No modern things.

CARS

These new set of guidelines have been put into place following the 2008 Steam Horse and Vintage Rally and in conjunction with the help of the Echuca Car Club.

Cars will be limited to pre 1959's This will allow us to have true vintage rally of 50 years plus.

Due to space the car section will be only permitted to display 200 vehicles. Car exhibitors will be permitted to have two (2) people enter for free. Anyone else in the car will need to pay the required fee.

The age of vehicles will be strictly adhered to in the following areas:

- Section 6.1 1900-1918 Veteran
- Section 6.2 1919-1930 Vintage
- Section 6.3 1931 – 1942 Classic Pre War
- Section 6.4 1950's Historic
- Section. 6.5 Special Interest (*Conditions apply*)
(This is the section that will have strict guide lines enforced. We wish to highlight these areas so that you can notify your club members so that when they arrive at our event they will not be turned away in disappointment.

All special interest exhibits must be received prior to the event. Closing date is the 22nd April. This date is so you are included in the official program if accepted.

No entry - No admittance

All entries received will be looked at and either accepted or denied.

Accepted exhibitors will receive a notification letter that you are accepted. This letter must be produced at the gate so that passes can be issued. No pass will be mailed out prior to event. Only acceptance letters and one car pass sticker that must be stuck to the window and displayed.

- Extra people in the car will need to pay the admission price set on the day or weekend.
Please note that every event in Australia has this standard practice, we are no different.

- Failure to display issued car sticker will see your vehicle not be permitted.

- Non acceptance exhibitors will be notified by return mail.

Special interest: This section will be looked at after entries close. If we have space available, a judging panel has been set up to look at each of the special interest entries to see if they warrant admission. In the past some of these entries may have been allowed to enter however with the implementation of the new guidelines we are sure that people will appreciate that we are staying with the true tradition of the Steam Horse and Vintage Rally.

OUTDOOR MARKET:

Home Grown, Home Made only. – No trash or treasure.

Indoor & Outdoor Market Holders

- You will need to supply all equipment including tents, chairs, tables, power, lighting, etc
- Vehicles are not to be parked on site, you will need to deliver your stock and park in the designated area. All cars must be removed by 9:00am on each day. Your site will be allocated upon check in. We do not promise positions to any exhibitor regardless of your previous positions. If you have requested a specific position we will do our best but there are no guarantees.

Camping – Limited spaces

- Only those that have pre booked will be permitted to camp.
- Those exhibitors who have booked for **camping** and have received their **allocated camping** card will be assigned a camp spot. Before setting up please report to the main office and obtain permission and a plan. No cars are permitted to remain in the rally grounds during the day.
- Campers are eligible to stay from Friday 5th June, however they must be cleared by Monday 8th 10:00am at the latest. No cars are permitted to be left in the area during the day.
- Toilet facilities are available. No showers. If you wish to camp you must pre book.

Pre entered Exhibitors

- Only exhibitors that have pre entered this year will be permitted to enter the event. Should people arrive that have not entered, they will by all means be able to attend the rally. However they will need to park in the public car park and will be required to pay an entry fee.
- Same as the normal spectators.

Security

Security has been arranged for Friday and Saturday nights from 6:00pm to 7:00am. No vehicle will be permitted to enter during these times. Please note: There is no security for Sunday night.

Admittance for all exhibitors

All registered exhibitors will have been issued with an acceptance letter to the event. This letter must be produced at the main gate to obtain your passes for the weekend.

If you arrive without an exhibit you will not be given your free passes.

If you arrive in a vehicle and there are more than two (2) people, the other people will be required to pay the day or weekend pass fee. DO NOT ARGUE or you may be excluded from the event.

Oil and Petrol Engine Personnel

- Only operators of engines and machinery and club members are to be allowed within the compound while engines and machinery are operating.
- Camping is permitted for this category only within the compound but vehicles must be removed by 9am each day.
- All operators must be over the age of 18 years.

Vintage Tractors and Equipment Personnel

- Only one person is to be on your tractor when the tractor is mobile. Maximum speed limit for tractors is 8km per hour.

Grand Parade – Invited car club only

- The invited Car Club vehicles will be the only cars permitted in the Grand Parade. This club will be located in the centre arena.
