Dear Exhibitor

Once again we are in preparations for this years Steam, Horse & Vintage Rally and we have introduced some changes. We have a new database which will keep track of all exhibitors and hopefully limit the amount of duplication.

You will find the specific detail requirements on the other side, however, it is important to read all of this information. In an attempt to reduce the amount of late entries we have changed the event set up times for exhibitors: -

CHECK IN: From 1pm – 7pm, Friday 7th June and 7am -9.00am, Saturday 7th June
Event Start Time: 8.30am, Saturday 7th June
Event Finish Time: 5pm, Sunday 8th June
CHECK OUT: From 5pm, Sunday 8th June through till 12pm, Monday 8th June.

If for some reason you are unable to comply with these guidelines, you will need to obtain special permission to set up from the Event Manager. Otherwise you may not be allowed on the site.

Camping - As always there are limited spots available to campers, therefore it's first in process. There will be no camping allowed outside of the designated areas without special permission. There will once again be toilet facilities available to the campers. There is no cost for camping this year, however please note spaces are limited.

Exhibitor Dinner - Please indicate if you will be attending the dinner, we will be charging exhibitors \$5 and then refunding the money when they turn up at the dinner. Additional people are welcome, with a costs of \$5 to per person.

Markets – Home grown – home made, No trash or treasure. Limited spots will be available to the indoor and outdoor markets and a further assessment of your products will be taken to ensure you fit within the guidelines of our Market objectives. A listing of specification guidelines will be posted on the website www.echucasteamrally.com.au. There is no separate form, fill your details on the back.

Dog Competition - The competition will be held again, again however we would like to see photo's of the dog with your entry. There is no separate form, fill your details on the back.

Insurance - It is important to stress that Public Risk Cover is Null and Void if Exhibitors and their machines do not comply with Statutory Regulations under Victorian Law pertaining to their exhibits. Exhibitors of Steam Engines and boilers must ensure their boiler or pressure vessel meets Statutory that are valid. Verification of Compliance and or Certificates of Inspection must be sighted by our Steam Co-coordinator before setting up. We welcome your most valued support as an Exhibitor and your compliance with the aforementioned regulations.
