The 48<sup>th</sup> Steam Horse and Vintage Rally will be held on the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> June 2010 located at Rotary Park, Echuca and will be a great weekend for everyone, including exhibitors and visitors to the event. The weekend will again see visitor numbers of between 8,000-10,000 people over the two day weekend event.

Special features of this years' event will be:

- ◆ The Re-enactment of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of "D-Day" by the military group. This special feature will be displayed on the main arena.
- ◆ To entertain the young families with be "Thomas the Tank Engine" steam engine coming from the Bellarine Peninsula to be displayed in its working glory.
- ◆ The Mini Motor Bike display by "Whip Industries" will feature on Saturday and the Vintage Car Club will also feature on Sunday and will entertain both young and old.

The traditional features of the rally will be on display with demonstrations by the Blacksmiths, whip cracking, the Aus Axeman, Horse, Vintage Tractors, Vintage Cars\* (Cars prior to 1960 accepted) along with the tasty Camp Kitchen and mouth watering scones from the Country Kitchen.

The miniature trains, pony rides, face painting along with the popular McLeod Pipe Band, Echuca Federal Band and Darryl the Singing Farmer along with other musicians will all be there.

**All exhibitors will receive 2 FREE passes.**

Extra tickets are available and can be purchased at any time.

**All exhibitors will be given either a 2010 Steam Rally Cap or a 2010 Exhibitor plaque.** *Please indicate your choice on the entry form.* Should you wish to have both they can be purchased for the cost of \$10 each. To receive a plaque or hat your entry form must be received by the 22nd April.

**Please complete your exhibitor form**, front and back and return by mail by the 1st April to be included in official program. Any entry forms received after this date may not be included in the official program as it is subject to time deadlines. Entries will be accepted after this date.

**Note:** When your entry has been received and processed, you will receive a notification letter of your acceptance. Passes will not be issued by mail this year and will be available for collection from a central point. This information will be included in your letter.

#### HORSE SECTION:

Only original horse drawn vehicles may be displayed.

#### INDOOR & OUTDOOR MARKET HOLDERS:

- You will need to supply all equipment including tents, chairs, tables, power, lighting, etc.
- Vehicles are not to be parked on site, you will need to deliver your stock and park in the designated area. All cars must be removed by 9:00am on each day.
- Your site will be allocated upon check in.
- We do not promise positions to any exhibitor regardless of your previous positions. If you have requested a specific position we will do our best but there are no guarantees.

#### Outdoor Market Holders:

Home Grown, Home Made only. No trash or treasure please.

#### BASIC CAMPING - LIMITED SPACES

- Those exhibitors who have booked for **Camping** and have received their **allocated camping** card will be assigned a camp spot. Before setting up please report to the main office and obtain the campsite plan.
- No cars are permitted to remain in the rally grounds during the daytime events.
- Campers are eligible to stay from Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June, however they must be cleared by Monday 14<sup>th</sup> 10:00am at the latest.
- Toilet facilities are available. No showers.
- Any campsites left available will be allocated on a first in basis.

#### SECURITY

Security has been arranged for Friday and Saturday nights from 6:00pm to 7:00am. No vehicle will be permitted to enter during these times.

Please note: There is limited security for Sunday night.

## CARS

The new guidelines set out by Echuca Steam Rally and the Echuca Car Club will continue with a cutoff date imposed where by the vehicles must be at least 50 years old.

Cars will be limited to pre 1960's. This will allow us to have a true vintage rally of 50 years plus.

Car exhibitors will be permitted to have two (2) people enter for free. Anyone else in the car will need to pay the required fee.

The age of vehicles will be strictly adhered to in the following areas:

- Section 6.1 1900-1918 Veteran
- Section 6.2 1919-1930 Vintage
- Section 6.3 1931 – 1942 Classic Pre War
- Section 6.4 1950's Historic
- Section 6.5 Special Interest \* (*Conditions apply*)

**\*All special interest exhibits** must be received prior to the event. Closing date is the 1<sup>st</sup> April. This date is so you are included in the official program if accepted. No entry - No admittance All entries received will be looked at and either accepted or denied. You will be advised either way.

- Accepted exhibitors will receive a notification letter that you are accepted.
- This letter must be produced at the gate so that passes can be issued.
- No passes will be mailed out prior to event, only acceptance letters and one car pass sticker that must be stuck to the window and displayed.
- **You must display your issued car sticker for your vehicle to be permitted entry.**
- Non acceptance exhibitors will be notified by return mail.
- Special Interest Exhibits are subject to acceptance by the Steam Rally Committee.

## ADMITTANCE FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

All registered exhibitors will have been issued with an acceptance letter to the event. Your acceptance letter must be produced at the main gate to obtain your passes for the weekend.

***If you arrive without an exhibit you will not be given your free passes.***

If you arrive in a vehicle and there are more than two (2) people, the other people will be required to pay the day or weekend pass fee.

## OIL AND PETROL ENGINE PERSONNEL

- Only operators of engines and machinery and club members are to be allowed within the compound while engines and machinery are operating.
- No camping is allowed permitted for this category only within the compound,
- All operators must be over the age of 18 years.

## VINTAGE TRACTORS AND EQUIPMENT PERSONNEL

- Only one person is to be on your tractor when the tractor is mobile unless the model has an extra original seating position. Maximum speed limit for tractors is 8km per hour

## GRAND PARADE - INVITED CAR CLUB ONLY

The invited car Club vehicles will be the only cars permitted in the Grand Parade.

Saturday 13th June: From 7:00am

### Event Start Time:

Saturday 12th June: 9:00am

### Event Finish Time:

Sunday 13th June: 4:30pm

**Check out:** from 5:00pm on Sunday 13th June through to Midday on Monday 14th June.
